SOLARIZE Edmonds Lutheran Church

Solar panels on the south-facing roof of the fellowship hall is closer to becoming a reality. We have been learning about this for a year now, and the council has voted to move forward. We are not going to make a big campaign out of this. Here's the breakdown of costs and funds needed.

Total cost of a 9.72 kilowatt system is \$39,805. A & R Solar, the installation company, is donating \$10,270. Itek Energy, the panel manufacturer, is donating \$4,185. That brings the total to \$25,350.

Two gifts of \$4,000 each have been received from ELC members. (*Wow. Thank you!!*) So now the balance is \$17,350. A local foundation, the Hazel Miller Foundation expressed interest in the possibility of matching the final \$10,000.00 towards the purchase and installation.
